“Getting Ready” is a free workshop run over 2 days (3 hours each day) for people with physical disability. The emphasis is goal setting and planning. The aim of the workshop is to develop skills so people with disability are able to become confident in planning for their supports and services as well as individualised funding arrangements. Information is also provided during the workshop relating to useful contacts and resources relating to the National Disability Insurance Scheme. Workshops are limited to up to 10 attendees to be able to maintain a personal focus to the topics that are discussed.
